*Reclaiming Life for Every Generation* was the theme for this year's **West Coast Walk for Life** in San Francisco.

On Saturday, January 21, 2023 more than 15,000 pro-lifers came together at the **Walk for Life West Coast**. At the rally prior to the **Walk**, Eva Muntean told the thousands in attendance:

*"For the first time, we stand together at the Walk for Life West Coast in a country where the so-called 'right' to kill an unborn child is no longer the law of the land. This is a battle we have been fighting for 50 years. Tomorrow (January 22, 2023) WOULD HAVE BEEN the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the atrocity of Roe v. Wade. Thanks to pro-lifers and to God Almighty, Roe will NOT HAVE a 50th birthday. And what that means is many thousands of children WILL HAVE a FIRST birthday!"*



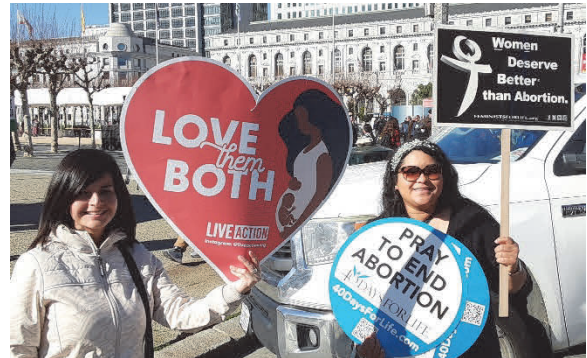
**The Pro-Life Generation, Lead the Walk for Life**

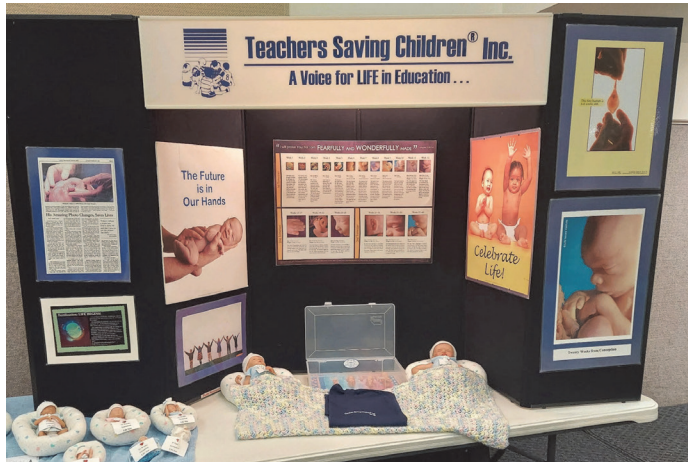
**All Ages Walk for Life in San Francisco**

The Heritage Reformed Baptist Church in Canton, Ohio has hosted a pro-life event, complete with speakers and exhibitors, for a number of years, and ***Teachers Saving Children*** has been invited for more than 5 years now. ***Teachers Saving Children*** Board of Trustees member, Jan Luke, has been a leader in being an advocate for life and sharing our pro-life message at the ***Made in His Image*** event every year.



**Wonder of Life Exhibit at our table**

This year's theme was "The Unchanging God". Wonderful speakers shared how human life, made in God's image and likeness, is precious and a treasure. "The murder of babies (abortion) is an offense to God", shared the keynote speaker, and we are called to do our best to protect the innocent lives in danger of abortion. Prayer, pro-life advocacy, support for mothers in crisis pregnancies, and foster care and adoption were practical suggestions we can do to be pro-life voices and advocates.

Terry and Jody Dillon, ***Teachers Saving Children*** members, Connie Bancroft (former Executive Director), and Gary Winney ***Teachers Saving Children*** Board of Trustees member all helped in various ways. For the second year in a row, thanks to your generous financial support, ***Teachers Saving Children*** donated \$500 worth of diapers which were presented to the local pregnancy help centers in and around Canton. Jan, who also performed with the SIGN (Signing In God's Name) choir, concurred that "This was a wonderful event!"

***What Can We Do if Businesses in Our Community Support Abortion?***

Following the Dobbs Supreme Court decision overturning *Roe v. Wade* on June 24, 2022, much has happened as state and the federal governments propose and enact various laws and executive orders. Some of the positive pro-life achievements were listed in our Winter, 2023 newsletter. Numerous big-name brands and/or companies, however, have come out publicly stating that they will fund abortion travel costs for their employees. What are we to do?

Here are some practical suggestions.

- 1) **Pray** for a conversion of hearts and minds.
- 2) **Be Informed.** [www.catholicleague.org](http://www.catholicleague.org) has a list of companies that pay for employee abortions.
- 3) **Write a letter, send an email or call.** If you go to the website of the company (**Disney, Apple, Amazon, JP Morgan, Starbucks, etc.**), usually at the bottom of the home page is **Contact Us** with information on phone number and address. Prepare your message such as, "I am calling to let you know that I liked your (product), but now that you are supporting abortion for your employees, I will find a similar product elsewhere."
- 4) **Choose local small businesses.** Here you can have a polite conversation with the owner and/or employees letting them know you are choosing their business, because they do not spend money supporting abortion.
- 5) **Choose businesses that are pro-life.** Concerned Women of America ([www.concernedwomen.org](http://www.concernedwomen.org)) provide alternative options to companies funding abortion travel for employees. For example, instead of AT&T, choose Charity Mobile; Instead of Starbucks, choose Seven Weeks Coffee.
